## Religious Sisters Serving Kansas City

When we look at the Kansas City area we note the many congregations represented and the diverse work they perform. We have those whose mission is to feed and aid homeless women, going so far as to sleep on the floor and give their beds to the homeless women staying with them.

Others go out into the homes in the community to care for the sick and suffering. They look after both their physical and spiritual needs.



There are Sisters who work for peace and justice. They maintain a place for retreats where people, no matter what their beliefs, might come and find peace.

Some Sisters live in poverty and spread the word of God, living as He did from the charity of others. Others teach our children, care for the sick and dying, and work as administrators in schools, colleges, and hospitals.

One thing these Sisters have in common is a love of Christ and they hold out their hand to those who might need help without worrying if they will be repaid.

Since 2015, the Serra Clubs have made grants of almost \$90,000 to religious orders for the education and formation of their sisters. Most of the funds used to provide these grants came from donations made in conjunction with the Religious Sisters' Appreciation Day.

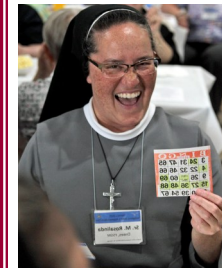
